

At *JRRD* we have updated our editorial policies and submission guidelines. You can find these revised documents at www.rehab.research.va.gov/jrrd, under Author Resources.

We hope you will find the changes helpful in preparing your manuscripts for submission to *JRRD*.

Some Important Changes

- *JRRD* uses CrossRef's iThenticate to screen all accepted manuscripts for plagiarism. Plagiarism includes copying or paraphrasing from others' or your own work, copying equations or figures, using previously published data, and using copied or altered photographs.
- *JRRD* now requires authors to describe their contributions to the study and/or manuscript; all authors must define a contribution.
- *JRRD* now requires that authors use the *ICMJE Form for Disclosure of Potential Conflicts of Interest*; this form is available as a fillable PDF.
- *JRRD* has created checklists for manuscript submission and figure preparation to help you with the submission process.
- *JRRD* accepts supplemental materials for publication as online appendixes; guidelines for submitting video and audio files are now available.
