

## PUBLICATION POLICY

1. All Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) investigators are required to submit articles emanating from VA Rehabilitation Research and Development (RR&D) funded research to the Journal of Rehabilitation Research and Development (JRRD) for first consideration of publication. Exceptions to this policy will be made at the discretion of the Editor-in-Chief. Support of JRRD is an obligation of every member of the VA RR&D community, and compliance with this policy is a performance measure that will be applied to all funded investigators.
2. Articles which are either excepted from this policy, or refused for acceptance by JRRD but accepted by another journal, must list the investigator's VA affiliation and acknowledge VA RR&D as a funding source (primary if that is the case).
3. When VA provides half or more of the salary support for the principal investigator, it shall be named first, regardless of whether VA is the primary source of funding or where the funds are administered.
4. Reprints of articles appearing in another publication must be sent to RR&D Service: 810 Vermont Avenue, NW (122A); Washington, DC, 20420.
5. Advance notice of publication in other sources is required (see VHA Handbook 1200.19).
